Big Idea

Discussion Questions

1. God is patient and He does not want anyone to die in his or her sins. People who have a short fuse will be agitated at the slightest offense, but God is long suffering. Why can a holy and powerful God be patient with us?
2. God is abundant in love, faithfulness, kindness, goodness, and truth. His constant love is not merely sufficient, but over owing. We must not take for granted the riches of God's kindness, tolerance, and patience, but realize that His kindness leads people toward repentance (Romans 2:4). How has God showed His abundant love for us (Romans 5:8-11

Prayer

Ask God for a greater understanding of His compassion, grace, love, and faithfulness.

Pray for the restoration of relationships among family and friends as they get to know the love and grace of God.

Pray for a heart of compassion towards people as we get to understand the compassion and kindness of God.
